- 1 **Raboso Rosé, Frizzante, Casa Defra** Italy 23.00
This is Pink Prosecco in all but name - Italian law does not allow it to be called that. A lightly sparkling (Frizzante) wine with an elegant finish.
- 2 **Prosecco, Bella Modella, Spumante** Italy 28.00
A full blown sparkling Prosecco made in the Spumante fashion. Delicate, fruity and perfectly balanced.

CHAMPAGNES

- 4 **Lombard, Brut (Magenta)** Épernay 43.00
Our choice of a little-known Champagne - delicious, fresh and elegant from one of Épernay's oldest houses.
- 5 **Louis Roederer, Brut Premier** Reims 56.00
From the makers of Cristal, this is perhaps the best non-vintage Champagne on the market.
- 7 **Laurent Perrier, Cuvée Rosé, Brut** Reims 76.00
Made from 100% Pinot Noir red grapes, a glorious pink colour with rounded red-fruit flavours.
- 8 **Moët et Chandon, Cuvée Dom Pérignon** Épernay 176.00
The "flagship" wine from the world renowned Champagne house.

WHITE WINES

- 10 **Trebbiano, IGT Veneto, Terre Allegre** Italy 18.50
A light, dry, crisp, yet easy drinking wine from the Trebbiano grape, the grape used for making Soave.
- 11 **Chardonnay, Dry River** Australia 19.50
Aromas of peach, citrus and lemon lead to tropical fruit flavours on the palate and a clean crisp finish - so says the winemaker. ½ Carafe 10.50
- 12 **Sauvignon Blanc, CYT, Central Valley, Concha y Toro** Chile 19.50
